

Girls Education : - Village: Gadhda. Taluka: Mahua. District: Bhavnagar Gadhda village belongs to Mahua Taluka in Bhavnagar District. Level of education was very low in this village. There are the problems of migration and dropouts in the village. Children go to the school irregularly. After primary education children do not go for further education. Village had wrong beliefs about education. Looking at this situation, Gram sabhas and rallies were organized on education awareness in the village. Child



fare and cluster level meetings also were held. This whole process helped to motivate village people and leaders to understand the educational situation in the village, village people and leaders were motivated by this whole process and understood their role in the village. They started to take interest in their children's education. This process helped to start LEP classes in the village. After starting LEP classes, it found that quality of education was improved and people started to pay contribution. For promotion of girl child education, anganwadi and Asha workers were trained to motivate the parents. They made efforts to contact parents and helped them to understand the importance of education for girls. Because of these efforts made by School Teachers, LEP Teacher, anganwadi and Asha workers 11 girls out of 21 girls were admitted in class 9 (Secondary Education) in Mahua. Now village people can see good results in the village. They have understood to provide good education to their children.
